

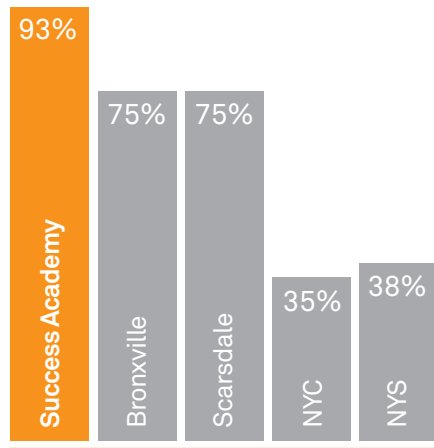
## Highlights of 2015 State Exam Results

**Success Academy dramatically outperformed the rest of New York City and New York State.**

- 93% of SA scholars passed the state math exam, compared to 35% in NYC and 38% in NY State.
- 68% of SA scholars passed the state ELA exam, compared to 30% in NYC and 31% in NY State.
- If SA were a single school, it would rank 11th out of 3,539 schools statewide in math. That is within the Top 1% of all New York Schools.
- If SA were a single school, it would rank 90th out of 3,543 schools statewide in English. This is among the Top 3% of schools.
- 68% of Success Academy scholars scored at Level 4 (Advanced) in math, compared to 15% of students citywide.
- In math, 5 of the top 10 schools across New York State are Success Academy schools (SA Bed-Stuy 1, SA Williamsburg, SA Upper West, SA Harlem 4, and SA Bronx 2).
  - 9 of the top 20 are Success Academy schools (in addition to above, SA Bronx 1, SA Harlem 5, SA Harlem 3, SA Cobble Hill).
  - SA Bed-Stuy 1 is the #1 non-selective school in New York State (#2 overall) and SA Williamsburg is #2.
- In ELA, 3 of the top 20 schools across New York State are Success Academy schools (SA Upper West is #15, SA Cobble Hill is #16, SA Bed-Stuy 1 is #18).

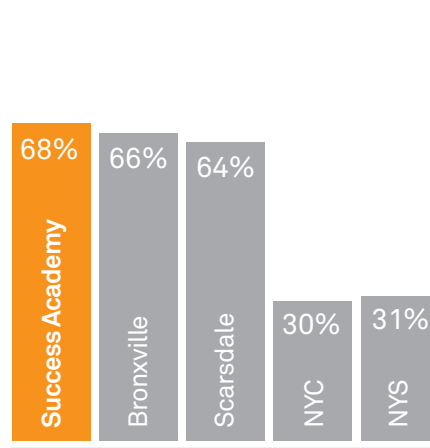
**Success Academy scholars passed math and ELA at higher rates than students in affluent suburban schools.**

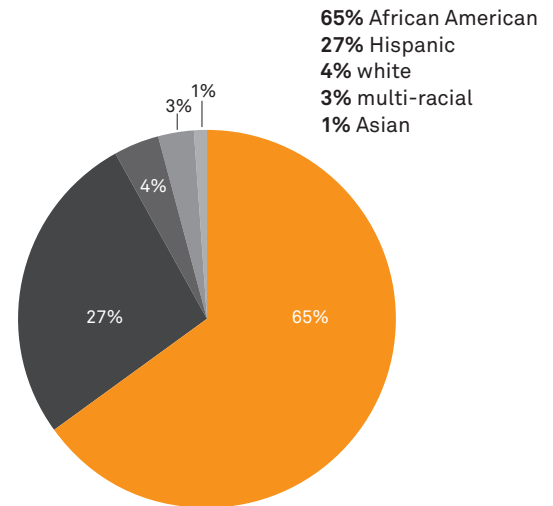
Ranked in the **Top 1%** of all New York schools

**There are 3,065 test takers at Success Academy.**

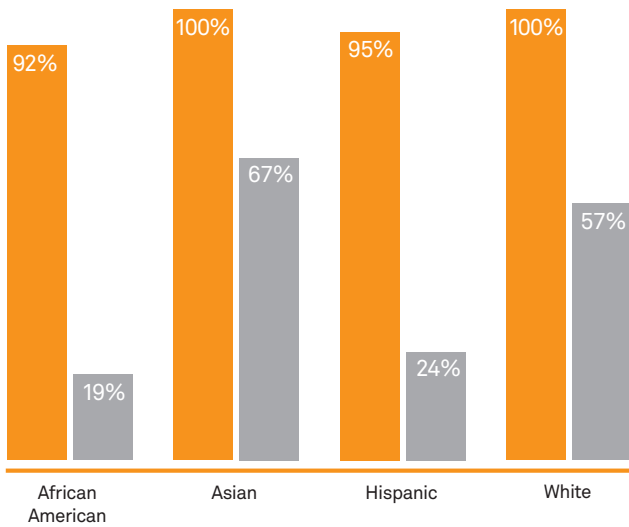

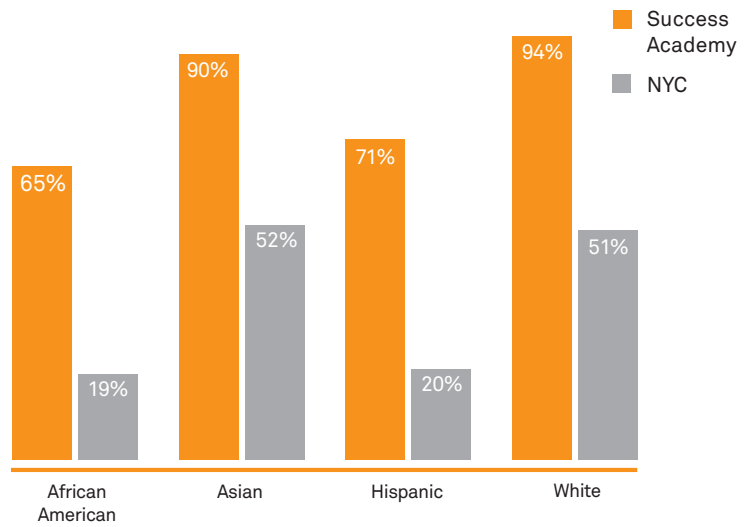
## Success Academy Scholars Reversed the Achievement Gap

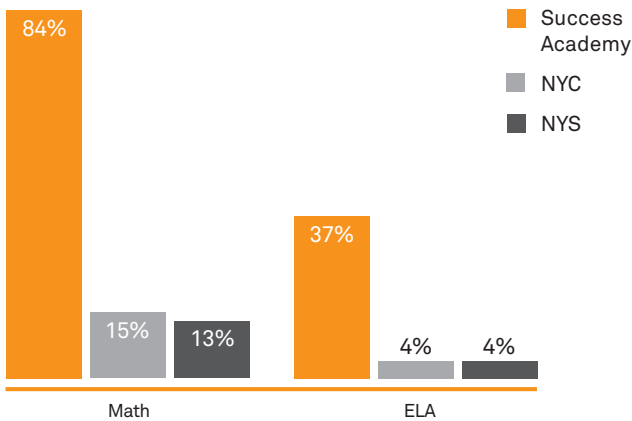

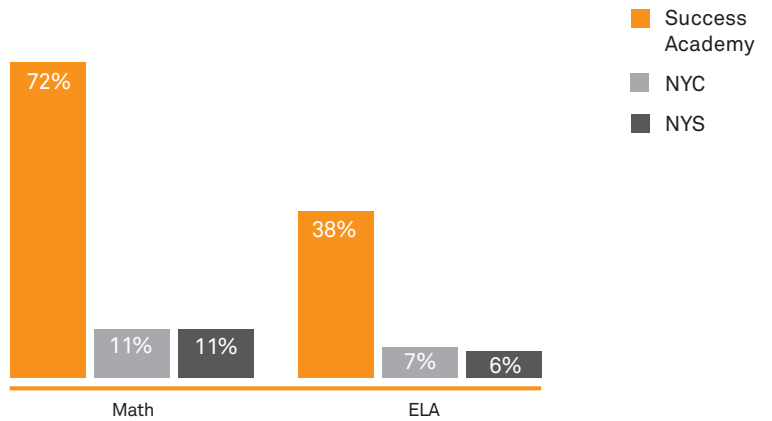
## English Language Learners

English Language Learners at Success Academy not only far exceeded their peers statewide, but also outperformed *non-ELLs* across New York.



## Students with Disabilities

Students with disabilities at Success Academy dramatically outperformed their peers throughout New York—as well as surpassing students without disabilities in math.



## School Highlights

- At SA Bed-Stuy 1, 100% of third graders passed math. There were only 8 schools in the state where all third graders passed math. The fourth grade cohort ranked 7th in the state in math, with a 99% pass rate.
- At SA Williamsburg, 99% of scholars passed math, which makes it the 3rd highest performing school in New York State.
- At SA Harlem Central, which was threatened with eviction by Mayor de Blasio in 2014, 100% of seventh graders passed math. Their seventh grade cohort tied with 2 other middle schools out of 1,420 schools statewide for #1. The school's sixth graders ranked 5th in the state with a 97% pass rate.
- The fifth graders at SA Bronx 1 ranked 6th in the state with a 97% pass rate.
